We recently conducted a number of pupil interviews to learn their opinions on what they like about school and what we could improve.

#### Strengths:

- All children said they enjoy school. They much prefer school to home learning because lessons are fun and they enjoy being with their friends.

- Many children are enjoying morning challenges when they first get to school and games to help them improve their mental maths knowledge.

#### Areas for development with actions being taken:
