Dear Parents and carers,

Thank you to all those of you who have completed the Parent Questionnaire online. You will receive a summary report of the responses to the Parent Questionnaire and also actions we have and are taking as a school in response to your feedback (we have already made some changes in response to feedback, so your views do make a difference!) Expect to see this in next week's newsletter so all responses MUST be in by end of today please.

A number of children are arriving in school wearing earrings. From September, we will be reinstating our Presentation Points System whereby EVERY class is expected to arrive in school wearing the correct unform (no trainers), long hair tied back, no jewellery and with a St. Mark's school jumper on. If you are thinking about getting your child's ears pierced, please do so at the start of the 6 week Summer holiday so that when your child returns, earrings can be taken out and this won't affect the class presentation point score.
