Swimming Summary Information 2021/22

Based on data from our swimming visits during the last academic year, these are the statistics for our 2021/22 Year 6 cohort:

Children who can perform safe self-rescue	27/30	90%
Children who can swim competently at least 25m	22/30	73.3%
Children who can use a range of strokes effectively	19/30	63.3%

Actions for 2022/23

This year, our approach is completely different due to our membership of the St John Bosco MAC. We will have a swimming pool on site for a 6-week half-term block. This will ensure that all classes get to use the pool and practice their swimming daily during this period. There are no transport costs or time lost through travel either. We are looking forward to seeing how effective this is. It will enable us to target specific groups in order to meet the 25m target, increase water confidence or to enable the more able to prepare for the annual swimming gala, which will be organised for March 2023.
