E-Safety Update—Spring Term 2023

Miss Stewart has been speaking to our children about E -Safety and how we, as a school, help support the children with being safe online. A recent survey found:

92% of our children enjoyed our E-Safety workshop and said it had taught them something new.

100% of children said they have used information they have learnt in lessons to stay safe online.

Our children have identified some ways to stay safe online:

"Never share your personal information and remember you have a digital footprint." (Y6 child)

"Everything that we do/say online is stored." (Y4 child)



"Be kind online like you would on the playground." (Y2 child)


