### Safeguarding Update - Traffic around school

A number of concerns have been raised recently by local residents and parents regarding parking/driving outside the school gates, particularly in the mornings. A reminder please that **there should be no stopping on any of the yellow lines or directly opposite the school gates.** Please show the children good examples of obeying road safety and parking. Our Junior PCSOs are eager to get back out on patrol but in order for us to keep them safe, we need parents to work with us to keep our roads safe. Driving and parking in an unsafe manner is putting your children at risk. Please allow extra time to park away from school and walk around with your child. Our school gates have staggered opening times (8:30—8:45am and 3:10—3:25pm) to allow for this to happen.

Walking to school also benefits the children as it is an opportunity to develop road safety skills

with their parents, increasing their confidence and overall levels of fitness. It is a cheap, low impact way to exercise, which impacts our health and mental well-being positively—even by parking slightly further away. Let's all work together to ensure our school area is a safe place.


